

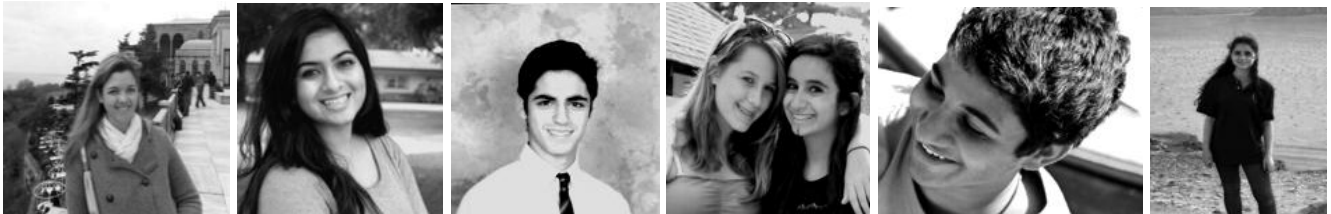


On Sunday, February 26, 2012, the B'nai Moshe Men's club will present a program called
